NBHOL BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTION

The North Boundary Home Owners League Bylaws provide for the election of the Board of Directors at the Bi-Annual membership meeting. The next election will be held at our Bi-Annual membership meeting on *June 21, 2000*. Each NBHOL member household is entitled to one vote in the election. To be eligible to vote, your household must be located in the North Boundary (bounded by Touhy, Kedzie, Howard and California), and be paid up in its 2000 NBHOL dues.

Nominations are now open for the Board of Directors election. If you wish to be considered for nomination to the Board of Directors, please complete the form at the bottom of

this page, detach and return it to: NBHOL, P.O. Box 59831, Chicago, Illinois 60659. To be eligible, your nomination must be received by May 3, 2000 and your household's 2000 dues must be received by that time.

(Only one person per household is permitted to serve on the Board of Directors at any one time.)

The NBHOL Bylaws provide for up to 20 Directors. There is no limit on the number of persons who can be nominated for the Board of Directors—you are eligible to serve on the Board of Directors if you live within the North Boundary area. Each term is four years, with half of the Board elected at each Bi-Annual membership meeting.
